The invention of science and technology reached its peak level. "Social triumphs, too, had been affected. H.G. Wells highlighted man defeated the Nature, he doesn't depend upon the nature, who has created he needs of human beings, he supplied the demand, everyone lived happy life. Nobody was doing any hard work or physical labour, they took highly nutritious food and maintained diet control, these are called Eloi fair in appearance they will roam everywhere in the imaginary world at day time. Morlocks appearance are not pleasant, they have gigantic appearance physically so powerful then Eloi, Morlocks are not having visual power in the day time, so they take rest in day time, night only they have visual power, in the night time Morlocks are tried to kill Eloi, Eloi never comes out of their house in the night time because of Morlock. Here the time traveller meets Weena one of the Elois, she is so affectionate in Time Traveller, wherever he goes in the Utopian World, Weena follows him.

The Palace of Green Porcelain:

(71) Now the Eloi were become very weak, they lost their ruling power, the Morlocks (Servants), once they were servants of Eloi, took reverse on Eloi, here H.G. Wells predicts the future happening of the world, evolution of Raising and falling of the people. In the night time Time Traveller tried to protect Weena from the Morlock. He had match Box in his pocket, used it to make fire, so Morlocks avoided to attack Time Traveller and Weena.

Death of Weena:

In one night there was fight between Time Traveller and Morlock, extreme level fight, Time Traveller burnt the forest for defending Morlock, finally in the war between Morlock and Time Traveller, he lost Weena, and she died in the burning fire. After the death of Weena Time Traveller found his Time Machine, which has been parked near White Sphinx, The Time Traveller gets entered into the Time Machine, again travelled to Three Million Years future.
